All children must wear either glasses or goggles.

The bus leaves school at 8.30am and returns to school by 3pm.

Children need a packed lunch and plenty of water. All personal gear is to be in a backpack.

We require a ratio of 1 adult to 5 children. Adult volunteers are required. Please fill out the attached form. Our school policy is that volunteers for skiing are Police vetted, if you need this done please see the office for the required forms.

Attached to this letter are; a gear list, a gear notification form, a volunteer helpers form with the days your child's class will be skiing, a Health Profile and a Parental Consent and Risk Disclosure form (please could you return the forms that we require completed as soon as possible). We hope this will make it easier for you to plan your days, if you intend to assist with class skiing please indicate what days you are available on the form. If you are intending to volunteer to assist with class skiing we will be holding a parent volunteers meeting before the end of term (see below).
