#### Life back at school

As we yet again found ourselves having to adapt to the

unpredictable nature of Covid-19 with the new Delta variant, I have to say I am incredibly thankful for the support we have received from our parent community and I also wish to thank our teachers for taking a second lockdown in their stride. Our children all returned to school with positivity last week and have all been very focused on their learning. Well done to everyone who worked at their best during the lockdown period – there was fabulous distance learning happening and learning stories shared.

In Level 2, we are hopeful that before we know it things will get back to as normal as they can. We have been here before and again there have been some cancellations and postponements of events, such as our speech night and inter school speech night which we know is very disappointing. An incredible amount of work has gone into oral presentations by our children and we look forward to the sharing of this work.

All decisions that have been and continue to be made are done so with the safety of everyone in mind and mitigating the risk factors of Delta.

#### **Vaccinations**

We have had some concerns from parents regarding vaccination roll outs in schools. Our school has not received any advice from the Ministry of Health to indicate that children will be vaccinated at school. As with any vaccination such as Bostrix etc consent would need to be given by parents and no vaccinations would happen without that.

#### Covid-19

While we are thankfully, not in the same position as the Auckland schools and communities, we are very familiar with requirements at Alert Level 2, and as a school will continue to emphasise the importance of:

- Good hand hygiene and cough and sneeze etiquette.
- Staying away if sick( but please call the office!)
- Keeping the appropriate physical distance from others- mask wearing is at discretion.
- Cleaning and disinfecting our high touch surfaces daily.
- Displaying QR code posters at our entrances so visitors to the school can scan in
- Restricting visitors on site


