2017 Principal Appointed

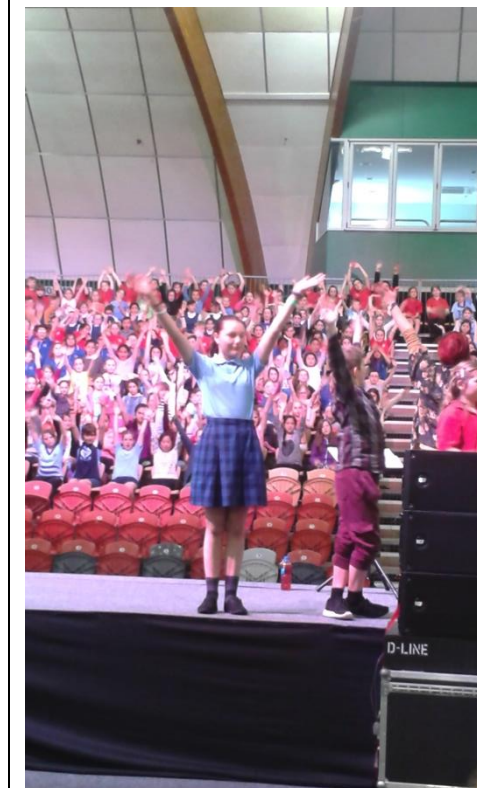
The Ohakune School Board of Trustees are excited to announce that we have appointed Lisa Clark to the Principal position starting 2017.
