School Trophies.

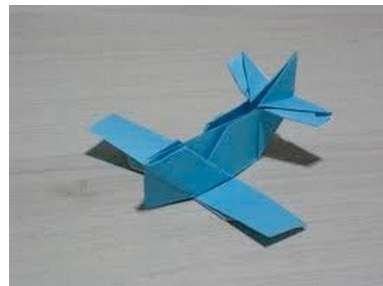
Thank you to those who have returned the school trophies to school. There are still a number of trophies yet to be returned in preparation for Final Assembly. Thank you.
