Car Park Safety

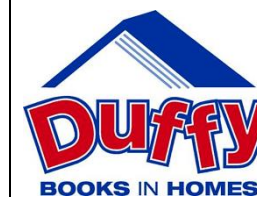
Parents please support our learners with safe practices in the car-park areas.
